About Amelia Earhart

Amelia Earhart was born on July 24, 1897 in Atchison, Kansas. She completed high school when she was 19 in Chicago 1906, to join the red cross first aid training. She worked as a nurse in World War 1. Earhart learned how to fly in 1920-21 in California. In 1922 she bought her first plane on June 17-18. It was yellow and she called it "Canary". When her parents divorced she moved back East where she was employed as a social worker in a dision house, in Boston, Massachusetts. There she was being selected as the first ever female passenger on a transletic flight in 1928, by

George Palmer Putnam, a publisher, and her future husband. In 1931 Amelia got married to George P. Putnam. She crossed the Atlantic Ocean in May 20-21, 1932. in January 1935 she made a solo flight from Hawaii to California. She sent out in 1937 to fly around the world, she completed more than two -thirds of the way their. Amelia vanished along with her navigator Fredrick Noonan. Amelia Mary Earhart died July 2, 1937 on How Island.

The Rumor of Amelia Earhart



looked burned. And soon enough the news started spreading that the pilot was a woman, and looked like Amelia Earhart.






Amelia's Flight Around The World
